# /. ABOUT THE ORIGARMY PROJECT

## 1 WHAT IS ORIGARMY?

The OrigArmy Project is the creation of Melbourne based Digital Creative Agency 10FOLD.

The idea behind OrigArmy is for creatives to make and share their unique 10 OrigArmy animals by applying their own personal style to each one. It is an opportunity for creatives to showcase their original flair, achieve recognition for their work and develop an online community to inspire ideas around the globe.

## 2 HOW DOES IT WORK?

The project will be running for 10 months, beginning on 01 February 2013 through to 15 December 2013. At the beginning of each month, the instructions for each OrigArmy animal will be available for download from [www.10FOLD.com.au/OrigArmy](http://www.10FOLD.com.au/OrigArmy)

To enter, simply construct your OrigArmy animal, take a photo and post it with your details on the 10FOLD Facebook wall. There will be a monthly winner and an overall annual winner.

## 3 WHO CAN ENTER?

Anyone can enter - whether you are an illustrator, designer, photographer, OrigArmy-ist, student, school or company. There are no limitations on how you style your OrigArmy animal, it can be a printed photograph, graffiti, wallpaper pattern or even manual style arts and crafts. The choice is yours!

## 4 HOW DO I ENTER?

- 4a. Download the instructional PDF each month from [www.10FOLD.com.au/OrigArmy](http://www.10FOLD.com.au/OrigArmy). Open the PDF in Adobe Illustrator or Photoshop and superimpose your unique design over the top of the diagram.
- 4b. Print off the page trimming the image to the square shape.
- 4c. Follow the OrigArmy instructions in the PDF to construct your animal.
- 4d. Take a photo of your masterpiece. Smart phone specs are standard.
- 4e. Visit [www.Facebook.com/10FoldCreative](http://www.Facebook.com/10FoldCreative) and post the image accompanied by your full name, location, institute or company and email address on the 10FOLD Facebook page.
- 4f. All entries will then be published on [www.Facebook.com/10FoldCreative](http://www.Facebook.com/10FoldCreative) page for public viewing and voting.
- 4g. Sign up to the 10FOLD newsletter at [www.10FOLD.com.au](http://www.10FOLD.com.au) to receive the announcement of the winners at the end of each month.
- 4h. Winners will be announced on the 5th of each month. Should the 5th fall on a weekend, the winner will be announced on the following business day. Don't forget to 'like' your favourites and share your creation with your friends to help your chances of winning!

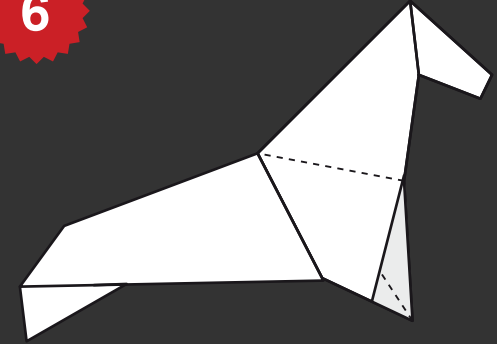

# SEAL

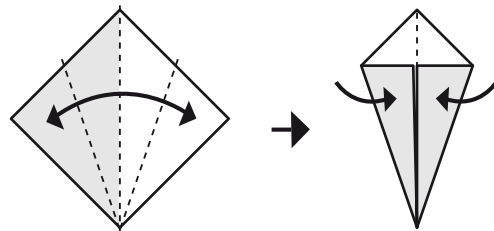
## 10 FACTS ABOUT SEALS

1. Seals find prey by detecting vibrations with their whiskers.
2. Seals were originally land animals with short limbs that have evolved into flippers over time.
3. Male seals are called bulls; females seals are called cows.
4. Seals can sleep underwater, surfacing to breathe without awakening.
5. Seals can be found accross the globe in both polar and tropical waters.
6. All seals are carnivores. Their diet consists mostly of fish, crustaceans and shellfish.
7. Seals can swim underwater for over 40 minutes.
8. The teeth of baby seals only grow when they eat something.
9. Seals spend most of their time in the water although they mate and give birth on land.
10. Seals hear very well in both water and air and can snort, hiss, growl or sneeze.

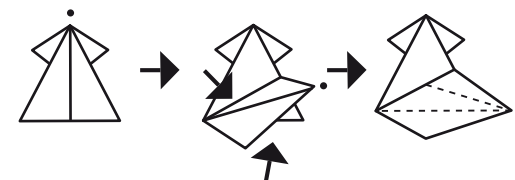
Fold paper in half along the dashed line and open again.

Then fold each side into the center to meet as shown.

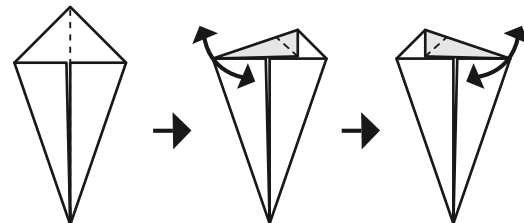
Flip the model over and fold the dotted corner down, opening the inside of the triangle slightly and squashing it flat like shown.

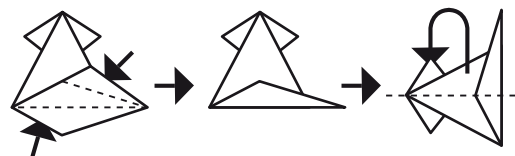
Fold the dotted corner down to meet the horizontal line, crease and then unfold.

Repeat on the other side.



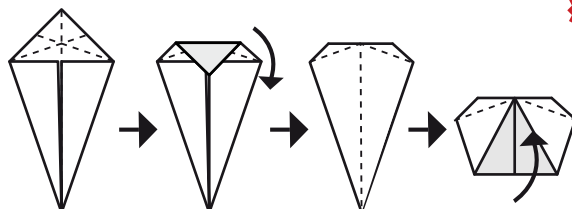

Fold the top and bottom corners on the front flap inside like shown. Then rotate the model anti-clockwise and fold in half, while still allowing the upper body to pop up.

Fold the top corner straight down, the middle of the fold should be on the intersection of the two creases created in step 2. Flip the model over and fold the bottom point up to the top as shown.



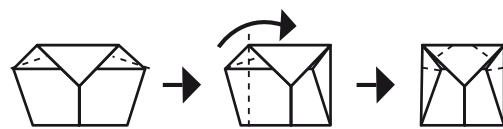

Form the front flippers by doing a inverse reverse fold as shown.



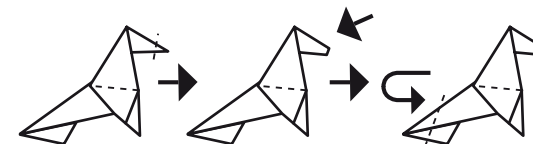

Flip the model over again and fold in the sides to create a rectangle shape.

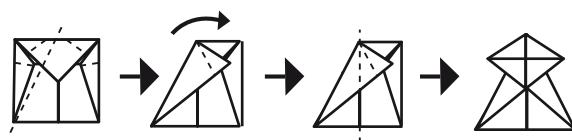
Crease along the seals head then reverse fold inwards, and square off the nose tucking it under the head. To shape the rear do an inside fold on the angle shown.

Fold the left side of the model on the angle shown. Then fold the inner corner outwards as shown.

Repeat on the right hand side.
