



Fold paper in half along the dotted Fold the rabbit in half and rotate to line, crease, and open again. the side. Then fold each side into the center to meet. Reverse fold the front section to Fold up each corner, crease, and form the rabbits nose. unfold. Then lift the inside corners, and squash down as shown. Then push up under the chin to form the head, and crease. Do this on all corners. Flip over, and fold top and bottom Reverse fold through the body to form the rabbit's feet as shown. flaps over as shown. Shape the rabbits back by folding Fold the top segment backwards on the sides inwards. the angles shown. Then gently use your fingers to shape the rabbits ears. Fold top of the rabbit back as shown, Take a photo of your rabbit and and allowing the back corners to pop up. post it with your details on the 10F0LD Facebook wall:

10 FACTS ABOUT RABBITS

- 1. Rabbits can see behind themselves but have blind spot in front of their face.
